Virgin Islands Port Authority Logo Design Contest

The Virgin Islands Port Authority (VIPA) will celebrate its Golden 50th Anniversary on February 11, 2019. As VIPA advances into the future, we would like to retire our old logo and develop a new symbol to represent our agency. The ports of the US Virgin Islands belong to the people of this territory. We would like the children in our communities to be involved in creating the new emblem which will be the primary representation of the Port Authority for many years to come.

We are hosting a design competition and invite all students from grades 7 through 12 to participate. The winning logo will be selected in **June 2018** and the winner (or winning team) will be asked to attend a press conference for the unveiling of the new logo and a monetary award. The criteria for the logo is as follows:

- To be eligible, each entrant must be a legal USVI resident and registered student in the 7th through 12th grade. Applicable students of all USVI schools (private, public and home schools) may submit an entry.
- A completed registration form must accompany each entry (see attached).
- Each submission must be accompanied by a short abstract of no more than 100 words, which explains the design idea and concept. Designers are required to pay attention to the history, mandate and activities of the VI Port Authority, which can be found online at www.viport.com.

- Individuals or teams may submit no more than two entries (a separate Entry Form must accompany each submission).
- All submitted work must be the original work of the entrant(s) and must not include, be based on, or derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks, or copyrighted images.
- All entries will become the property of the Virgin Islands Port Authority, which is an autonomous agency of the USVI government.
- By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees that any and all intellectual property rights in the logo design are deemed assigned to the Virgin Islands Port Authority
- Except where prohibited by law, an entry submission into this contest constitutes permission to use the winner's name and photograph.
- The logo should be colorful and recognizable and include a depiction of the port transportation industry and/or USVI culture.
- Entries should make no political statement.
