## **Bourne Field Residents Advised of Neighborhood Cleanup**

The Virgin Islands Port Authority advises the public of the major cleaning and landscaping of the Bourne Field residential community, which is owned by the Authority. VIPA awarded a \$26,700 contract to Boschulte Landscaping via a competitive bidding process to clean, clear, prune, cut and remove bush and debris throughout the neighborhood. The cleanup begins on **Monday, August 5, 2019**, and will take about two weeks to complete. Residents are asked to remove all personal items outside their unit and to secure their dogs to protect the individuals conducting the cleanup. VIPA police have also tagged abandoned and derelict vehicles parked in Bourne Field and have begun to tow the vehicles.
