The Virgin Islands Port Authority has reported an apparent security breach at its Administrative Building in Lindbergh Bay, St. Thomas. The building is currently undergoing hurricane damage repairs. The matter is being investigated by the VIPA's Police Department and the Virgin Islands Police Department, said VIPA's Acting Executive Director Damian Cartwright.
